Manifestation = Gk *Phanerosis*


Phaneroo [verb] = to make visible, to uncover, to lay bare.


Phaneros [adject] = to be open to sight, visible, manifest


Root Phaino = to cause to shine


Derivation: Phao/ Phos = light



Bible Marking

God "manifestation" = phanerosis

to make something visible or open to sight.
From root phaino to shine
Derived from Phos = light

Manifestation needs light 1 Cor 4v5, Eph 5v13, John 3v19-21

Light comes from God – 1 John 1v5

Purpose is to direct attention back to God, by what we manifest or show or do: John 3v21, Matt 5v16

Christ manifested God 1 Pet 1v18-21 2 Cor 4v5-6
