

<u>Israel</u> has sinned...


Jos 7:1 Bu the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel.

Jos 7:11 Israel hath sinned, and they have also transgressed my covenant which I commanded them: for they have even taken of the accursed thing, and have also stolen, and dissembled also, and they have put it even among their own stuff.

Jos 7:12 Therefore the children of Israel could not stand before their enemies, but turned their backs before their enemies, because they were accursed: neither will I be with you any more, except ye destroy the accursed from among you.

Jos 7:16 So Joshua rose up early in the morning, and brought Israel by their tribes; and the tribe of Judah was taken:

Jos 6:2 And the LORD said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand pricho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour.




Jos 8:7 Then we shall rise up from the ambush, and seize upon the city: for Yahweh your God will deliver it into your hand.



Not just strategic - SPIRITUAI

Gen 13:1 Abram went of Egypt he, his wife and all that he had...


- 3 And he went on his journeys from the south even to Bethel, unto the place where his tent had been at the beginning, between Bethe and Ai;
- 4 Unto the place of the altar, which he had made there at the first: and there Abram called on the name of Yahweh.
- 14,15 And Yahweh said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him. Lift up now thine eyes, and look from the place where thou art northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward: For all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed for ever.

Not just strategic - SPIRITUAI

Gen 12:4 So Abram departed, as Yahweh had spoken unto him; and Lot went with him: and Abram was seventy and five years old when he departed out of Haran.

- 6 And Abram passed through the land unto the place of **Shechem**, unto the oak of Moreh. And the Canaanite was then in the land.
- 7 And Yahweh appeared unto Abram, and said,

 Unto thy seed will I give this land; and there builded he an altar unto Yahweh, who appeared unto him.
- 8 And he removed from thence unto a mountain on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, having Bethel on the west and Ai on the east and there he builded an altar unto Yahweh, and called upon the name of Yahweh.



"Let not all go up..."

A half-hearted battle — Sure signs of defeat!

Human Reticence - "Let not ALL go up" cp 8:3,4,5,11,13 — the importance of communal effort by every individual is the only method for real success

Human Evaluation - "Only 2-3,000" Deut 32:30 "One shall chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight..." — God is with us, why stress out too much!

Human Apathy - "Not all <u>labour</u>" - They had been exhausted from the continuous march around Jericho for a week (But why worn out? - the city fell down due to God's activity)

Human Indifference - "they are but few" - The enemy will be easily defeated - it was not worth the extra effort! cp 8:25

Human Independence - No direction was sought from Yahweh cp 8:1 "And <u>Yahweh</u> said unto Joshua..."

"and they fled before the men of Ai...."



Sin is serious to God

Sin is serious because it is **repulsive** to God.

Hab 1:13 Thou art of purer eyes than to behold evil, and cannot look on iniquity

Sin is serious to God because it <u>desensitizes</u> us spiritually.

1 John 1:8, If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

Sin is serious to God because it **separates** us from God.

Proverbs 15:29 – Yah is far from wicked, But He hears prayer of righteous.

Psalm 66:18 - If I regard iniquity in my heart, The Lord will not hear.

Sin is serious because it **hinders** our walk with the Lord.

Isaiah 59:1-2 Your iniquities have separated you from your God; and your sins have hidden His face from you, so that He will not hear."

Sin is serious; stay away from it.



Double Emphasis

1Cor 6:9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,

v10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

6 Opportunities to repent

There were <u>numerous</u> opportunities for Achan to seek mercy...

v5 36 Families lost their husband/father - UNAFFECTED

v6 Joshua mourned all day long — **SHRUGGED OFF**

v13 Public warning judgement was impending - INDIFFERENT

v14 Had all night to act - DELAYED

v16 Had opportunity to step forward - DENIAL

v19 Joshua had to compel him to confess - DISCONNECTED



For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil. Ecc 12:14

I have sinned

Joshua 7:21 When I saw among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver, and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then I coveted them, and took them; and, behold, they are hid in the earth in the midst of my tent, and the silver under it.



Gen 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.







Not just a gold bar.

The graven images of their goes shall ye burn with fire: thou shalt not desire the silver or gold that is on them, nor take it unto thee, lest thou be snared therein: for it is an abomination to the LORD thy God. Neither shalt thou bring an abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it: but thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it is a cursed thing. (Deut 7:25-26)

If thy brother, son, daughter, wife, or thy friend, entice thee secretly, saying, Let us go and serve other gods, which thou hast not known, thou, nor thy fathers; Namely, of the gods of the people which are round about you, nigh unto thee... Thou shalt not consent unto him, nor hearken unto him; neither shall thine eye pity him, neither shalt thou spare, neither shalt thou conceal him... And thou shalt stone him with stones. That he die... And all Israel shall hear, and fear, and snall do no more any such wickedness as this is among you. (Deut 13:6-11)

What's in your tent?

Deut 7:25,26 Burn their idols. Do not desire the silver or gold that is on them, and do not take it for yourselves. If you do, that will be fatal, because Yahweh hates idolatry. Do not bring any of these idols into your homes, or the same curse will be on you that is on them. (GNB)

Lk 12.2 There is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; neither hid, that shall not be known.

1Cor 4:5 The will Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts

Heb 4:13: "There is nothing hidden from God's sight, but all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to do."



Absolute obedience to God

Jos 7:24 And Joshua, and all Israel with him, took Achan the son of Zerak, and the silver, and the garment, and the wedge of gold, and his sons, and his daughters, and his oxen, and his asses, and his sheep, and his tent, and all that he had: and they brought them unto the valley of Achor.

Jos 22:20 Did not Achan the son of Zerah commit a trespass in the accursed thing, and wrath fell on all the congregation of Israel? and that man perished MOT ALONE in his iniquity.

Prov 24:16 "For a just man falleth seven times, <u>and riseth</u> <u>up again</u>: but the wicked shall fall into mischief."





Deut 31:6,7 Be strong and of a good courage, fear not, nor be afraid of them: for Yahweh thy God, he it is that doth go with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

Joshua's leadership - going beyond defeat

Jos 8:3 So Joshua arose, and all the people of war, to go up against Ai:
and Joshua chose out thirty thousand mighty men of valour

- 9 Joshua therefore sent them forth... but Joshua lodged that night
- 10 And Joshua rose up early in the morning, and numbered the people,
- 13 ...Joshua went that night into the midst of the valley.
- 15 And Joshua and all Israel made as if they were beaten before them
- 16 ... and they pursued after Joshua, and were drawn away from the city.
- 18 And the LORD said unto Joshua, Stretch out the spear that is in thy hand toward Ai; for I will give it into thine hand. And Joshua stretched out the spear
- 21 And when Joshua and all Israel saw that the ambush had taken the city
- 26 For Joshua drew not his hand back, wherewith he stretched out the spear
- 28 And Joshua burnt Ai, and made it an heap for ever,
