# To Go out, and Come in

**2 Sam 5v2** The people say to David: Also in time past, when Saul was king over us, thou wast he that leddest out and broughtest in Israel: and Yahweh said to thee, Thou shalt feed my people Israel, and thou shalt be a captain over Israel.

**Numb 27v16-17** Let Yahweh, the God of the spirits of all flesh, set a man over the congregation, Which may go out before them, and which may go in before them, and which may lead them out, and which may bring them in; that the congregation of Yahweh be not as sheep which have no shepherd.

# Wisdom - Hakam

*TWOT: The essential idea of hakam represents a manner of thinking and attitude concerning life's experiences; including matters of general interest and basic morality, These concerns relate to prudence in secular affairs, skills in the arts, moral sensitivity, and experience in the ways of the Lord.....*

*The wisdom of the OT however, is quite distinct from other ancient world views ... Reflected in OT wisdom is the teaching of a personal God who is holy and just and who expects those who know him to exhibit his character in the many practical affairs of life. .... Therefore, Hebrew wisdom was not theoretical and speculative. It was practical, based on revealed principles of right and wrong, to be lived out in daily life*

# Riches or Wisdom?

**Prov 3v13-15** Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding. For the merchandise of it is better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold. She is more precious than rubies: and all the things thou canst desire are not to be compared unto her.

**Prov 16v16** How much better is it to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver!



# Ask what I shall give thee..

**Matt 7v 7-8** Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

**1 John 5 v14-15** And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.
