


the creation

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Genesis 1:1 NKJV

What Gen 1:1 tells us about the universe

It was **created** – it didn't appear spontaneously

It was created with intent, purpose, meaning

It has a **beginning** – as matter, as time

It encompasses everything that there is – "heaven and earth" idiom

It contains all of space and all of time

Laws established in the beginning were essential for the purpose of the universe.

What Gen 1:1 tells us about God

God is a **creator** and God is THE Creator – God is omnipotent
God **existed before** the universe came into being – God is eternal
God is **greater** than the universe – it is a product of His will
God exists **outside of space and time** and is bounded by neither
God created a **distinction** between heaven and earth
God added a **spiritual realm** to the physical universe.


First 4 chapters of Genesis...

teach the principles of a God-purposed life

- Separation of light from dark, day from night, waters above & beneath
- Separation of earth from sea
- Earth to bring forth life of its own
- Two main kingdoms as a result: plant kingdom, animal kingdom
- Separation between animals and man
- The imposition of laws and principles for sustainable life
- The rule of free-will established of reasoned behaviour
- Separation between animalistic thinking and Godly thinking
- Dealing with failure and error and its consequences of separation
- Principles of restoration and recovery.

emphasis on the **word** of God

*thought, intent, action





By trusting, we understand that the universe was created through **a spoken word of God**, so that what is seen did not come into being out of existing phenomena.



Genesis teaches the **why** not the how

"I am the LORD, and there is no other.





modern science

Chemical



Without any of these – there would be **no life**




a fine-tuned universe

fine-tuning of the Universe in



N – if smaller, only a small and short-lived universe could exist

Epsilon – If 0.006 or above, **only hydrogen could exist**, and **complex chemistry would be impossible**

Omega – if too big the universe would have collapsed, if too weak, no stars would have formed

Lambda – If not extremely small and stable, no stars and galaxies would be able to form


 \bigcirc – If too small, **no stars could form**, if too large, **no stars could survive** the violent universe


- life could not exist if there were 2 or 4 dimensions










Romans 1:19-20 CJB


Therefore, they have no excuse...

Colossians 1:15-20 NKJV

[Jesus] is the image of the invisible God, **the firstborn over all creation**. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers.

All things were created **through Him and for Him**. And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things **He may have the preeminence**.

For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on **earth** or things in **heaven**, having made peace through the blood of His cross.
