




THE BATTLE OF BETH-HORON (JOSHUA 10)




Joshua led his army on a forced overnight march from Gilgal up into the hill country, defeating the Canaanitish kings at Gibeon. He then chased them down into the Valley of Aijalon.









On either end of the "hump" there are two famous plains




The land will be turned to a plain (Arabah) from Geba to Rimmon.
A distance of roughly 60 km.

Why?





This explains why the land must be flattened for this distance





CHANGES EFFECTED BY EARTHQUAKE

- Destruction of Gog (Ezek. 38:18-23)
- Land flattened to pave way for Temple worship
- Clear a path for Jews escaping the Land (v.5)
- Open a way for those returning with Elijah in the 2nd Exodus (Hos. 2:14-15, Isa. 65:10)
- Allow living waters to flow down from the altar into the Dead Sea, thus healing it (Ezek. 47)




View of the Sanctuary. Ezekiel 40-47.

ZECHARIAH 14:6-7

- "that the light shall not be clear nor dark" Bro.

 Thomas translates, "it shall be in that day, there shall be no brightness, the splendid ones drawing in". This is followed by the Revised Version. Christ and the Saints initially withdraw their full glory (Hab. 3:4) as a test to the world.
- "but it shall come to pass that at evening time, there shall be light" Once the day (40 years) of judgement is passed, the light of the glorified Saints will be seen in full radiance.

THE BATTLE OF BETH-HORON



- Yahweh fought (Zech. 14:3, Josh. 10:14)
- At evening time, shall be light (Zech. 14:6, Josh.10:13)
- All the Saints with thee (Zech. 14:5, Josh. 10:7)
- No more the Canaanite in the house of Yahweh (Zech. 14:21, Josh. 10:1)
- The King (Zech. 14:9,16, Josh. 10:1)
