### Jerusalem


Deut 33:2 The LORD came from Sinai .... With ten thousands of saints ....

Hab 3: 2-15 A prophecy concerning the return of Christ through to the battle of Armageddon. The scene begins in Vs 3 at Mt Sinai.










# The 3 reactions of People when we are taken to be judged








Those who will be totally un-prepared and fearful




### The Book of Remembrance.




### The Process of Judgement


- 1: Our life is reviewed by our personal Angel directly from the Book of Remembrance Mal 3:16, Psa 56:8, Rev 20: 12-15
- 2: Our Angel will present us to Christ for the final judgement Rev 3:5, Luke 12:8-9
- **3**: Christ will be given the authority from his Father to decide our fate John 5:19-28
- 4: If our names are "written in Heaven" and recorded in the Book of Life then we will hear those words "Well done .... enter into the Joy of thy Lord" Heb 12:23, Matt 25:21
