


Romans 11:26

The "evil" of Jacob's life


- Grew up in a divided home
- Lived with murderous hatred of brother
- Injustice of a ruthless employer
- Deceived over matter of his wife
- 2 wives → division, tension, trouble
- Anguish of Rachel's barrenness
- Suffered the loss of Joseph
- Daughter left Truth → world
- Older sons rebellious

Esau - Man of the Flesh


- Esau = "to make" → fully formed, no change
- Red hair all over = child of flesh
- Called "Edom" = red
- Man of the field, cunning hunter
- City builder
- Profane (=irreligious) despised birthright
- Unaware of Providence
- Married Hittite women
- Hated of God "Esau have I hated"

Jacob - Man of the Spirit

- Upright, Godly man
- Tent-dweller → pilgrim, sojourner
- Loved the Promises
- Aware of Providence
- Married bride "close to Truth"
- Loved of God "Jacob have I loved"

Rebekah Woman of Initiative, Purpose & Action

- "she hasted ... gave him drink" 24:18
- "she hasted ... drew for his camels" 24:20
- "she ran ... told her mother's house" 24:28
- She said, "I will go" (to be Isaac's wife) 24:58
- Obey my voice: "Go... fetch two kids ..." 27:9
- Obey my voice: "Arise and flee..." 27:43

Rebekah Woman of Faith

- "Followed" Abraham's servant 24:61
- "Enquired of Yahweh" 25:22
- Believed the promise of angel 25:23
- Loved Jacob (godly man) 25:28
- Grieved by Esau's marriages 26:35
- Motivated by Divine promise 27:15, 42
- Buried with Isaac in Macpelah 49:31




The Voice of the Syrian

- Deceives


The Voice of the Syrian RETURNS
