- The captain of the host - Sisera (Battle array)

“**LORD, when thou wentest out of Seir, when thou marchedst out of the field of Edom, the earth trembled, and the heavens dropped, the clouds also dropped water.**” (Judges 5:4)

“**O God, when thou wentest forth before thy people, when thou didst march through the wilderness; Selah. The earth shook, the heavens also dropped** at the presence of God: *even Sinai itself was moved* at the presence of God, the God of Israel. **Thou, O God, didst send a plentiful rain,** whereby thou didst confirm thine inheritance, when it was weary.”(Psalm 68:7-9)

Psalm 68:17 - The **chariots of God** are 20,000 (double Judges 4:10)

Psalm 68:18 - **led captivity captive** (Judges 5:12)

Psalm 68:21 - God shall **wound the head** of his enemies (Judges 5:26)

Psalm 68:34 - His [God's] **strength is in the clouds** (Judges 5:4)

Habakkuk 3

V3 - From Teman and Paran - Sinai (Judges 5:4)

V5 - **Burning coals went forth at his feet** (Revelation 10:1)

v8 & 15 - **thy chariots and horses rode through the waters** (contrast)

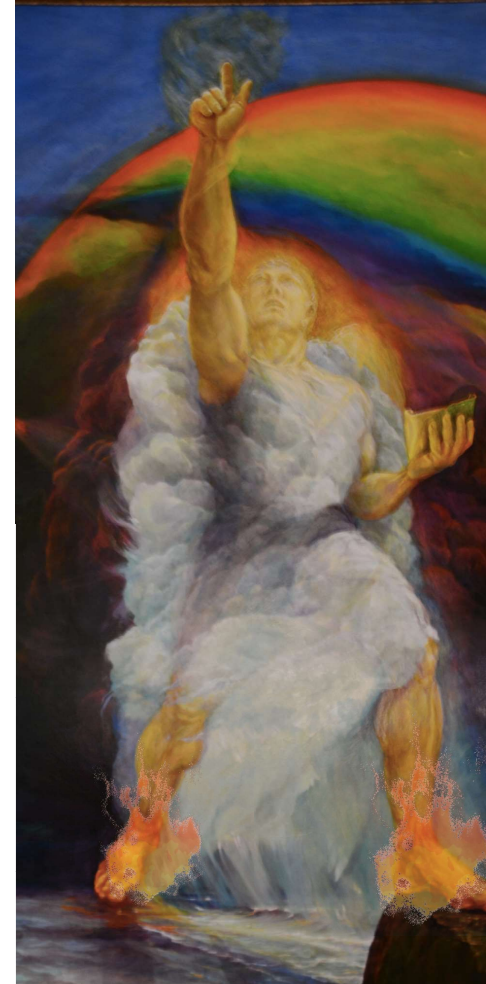
V10 - The mountains saw thee and they **trembled** (Judges 5:4)

V11 - at the shining of thy **glittering** spear (Judges 4:6)

V12 - **march** through the land (Judges 5:4)

V13 - **woundest** the head (Judges 5:26)

“And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, **clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire** (Revelation 10:1)



“Clothed with a cloud”

Judges 5:4 - “The clouds also dropped water”

“”Ascribe ye strength unto God: his excellency *is* over Israel, and his **strength *is* in the clouds.**” (Psalm 68:34)

“**My doctrine shall drop as the rain**, my speech shall distill as the **dew**, as the **small rain** upon the tender herb, and as the **showers upon the grass.**”
(Deuteronomy 32:2)

“A flash of lightning”

- **Barak** (H1301) - The same as H1300, from H1299

“And the LORD shall be seen over them, and **his arrow shall go forth as the lightning**; and the Lord GOD shall blow the trumpet, and shall go with whirlwinds of the south” (Zechariah 9:14)

“And the living creatures ran and returned **as the appearance of a flash of lightning.**” (Ezekiel 1:13-14)

“For **as the lightning cometh out of the east**, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. (Matthew 24:17)

“Iron does not mix with clay”

“And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but **they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay.” (Daniel 2:43)**



“The sun of righteousness”

“So let all thine enemies perish, O LORD: but *let* **them that love him** *be as the sun when he goeth forth in his might*. And the land had rest forty years.” (Judges 5:31)

“But unto you that fear my name shall **the Sun of righteousness** arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall **go forth**, and grow up as calves of the stall.” (Malachi 4:2)

“And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the **kings of the east** **[the king's from the sun's rising]** might be prepared.” (Revelation 16:12)
