



"Whosoever is fearful and afraid, let him return and depart early from mount Gilead. And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there remained ten thousand.." (Judges 7:3)

"He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. **But the fearful, and unbelieving...** shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death." (Revelation 21:7-8)

The principle of Deuteronomy 20:1-8 - go home if you're afraid!

"For many are called, but few are chosen" (Matthew 22:14)

#### How do we drink from the brook?

"So he brought down the people unto the water: and the LORD said unto Gideon, Every one that lappeth of the water with his tongue, as a dog lappeth, him shalt thou set by himself; likewise every one that boweth down upon his knees to drink. And the number of them that lapped, putting their hand to their mouth, were three hundred men: but all the rest of the people bowed down upon their knees to drink water." (Judges 7:5-6)

"O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him." (Psalm 34:8)

### "A cake of barley bread"

"And when Gideon was come, behold, there was a man that told a dream unto his fellow, and said, Behold, I dreamed a dream, and, lo, a cake [rolling round] of barley bread

 Barley - the first fruits - Gideon is the type of Christ - 1 Corinthians 15:20-23)

"Barley-meal was rather food for dogs or cattle than for men; and therefore the barley cake would be the emblem of a thing despised." (Spurgeon)

"And base things of the world, and **things which are despised, hath God chosen**, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are:" (1 Corinthians 1:28)



#### "Smote it that it fell"

"And when Gideon was come, behold, there was a man that told a dream unto his fellow, and said, Behold, I dreamed a dream, and, Io, a cake [rolling - round] of barley bread tumbled [overthrew] into the host of Midian, and came unto a tent, and smote it that it fell, and overturned [overthrew - turned on its head] it, that the tent lay along." (Judges 7:13)

"And David put his hand in his bag, and took thence a stone, and slang it, and **smote** the Philistine in his forehead, that the stone sunk into his forehead; and **he fell** upon his face to the earth." (1 Samuel 17:49)

## Mighty ones as one man

"And the angel of the LORD appeared unto him, and said unto him, The LORD *is* with thee, thou **mighty man of valour**." (Judges 6:12)

"Assemble yourselves, and come, all ye heathen, and gather yourselves together round about: thither cause thy **mighty ones** to come down, O LORD." (Joel 3:11)

"And the LORD said unto him, Surely I will be with thee, and thou shalt smite the Midianites as one man." Judges 6:16

#### The One Man

"Then I lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a certain man clothed in linen, whose loins were girded with fine gold of Uphaz: His body also was like the beryl, and his face as the appearance of lightning, and his eyes as lamps of fire, and his arms and his feet like in colour to polished brass, and the voice of his words like the voice of a multitude." (Daniel 10:5-6)

#### The One Man

"And he said unto them, Look on me, and do likewise: and, behold, when I come to the outside of the camp, it shall be *that*, as I do, so shall ye do." (Judges 7:17)

"And the three companies blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers, and held the lamps in their left hands, and the trumpets in their right hands to blow withal: and they cried, The sword of the LORD, and of Gideon. And they stood every man in his place round about the camp: and all the host ran, and cried, and fled. And the three hundred blew the trumpets, and the LORD set every man's sword against his fellow, even throughout all the host" (Judges 7:20-22)



### "Against his brother"


"And I will call for a sword against him throughout all my mountains, saith the Lord GOD: every man's sword shall be against his brother. ### The slaughter of Midian

"Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD of hosts, O my people that dwellest in Zion, be not afraid of the Assyrian: he shall smite thee with a rod, and shall lift up his staff against thee, after the manner of Egypt.
