Emotions

Groaned = GK 1690 = embrimaomai
to have indignation, to blame, to murmur against

38 Jesus therefore again **groaning [G1690] in himself** cometh to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay upon it.

v44	Bound by grave clothes	John 20:5	Clothes lying but no body
V44	Face bound with napkin	John 20:7	Napkin wrapped together, by itself

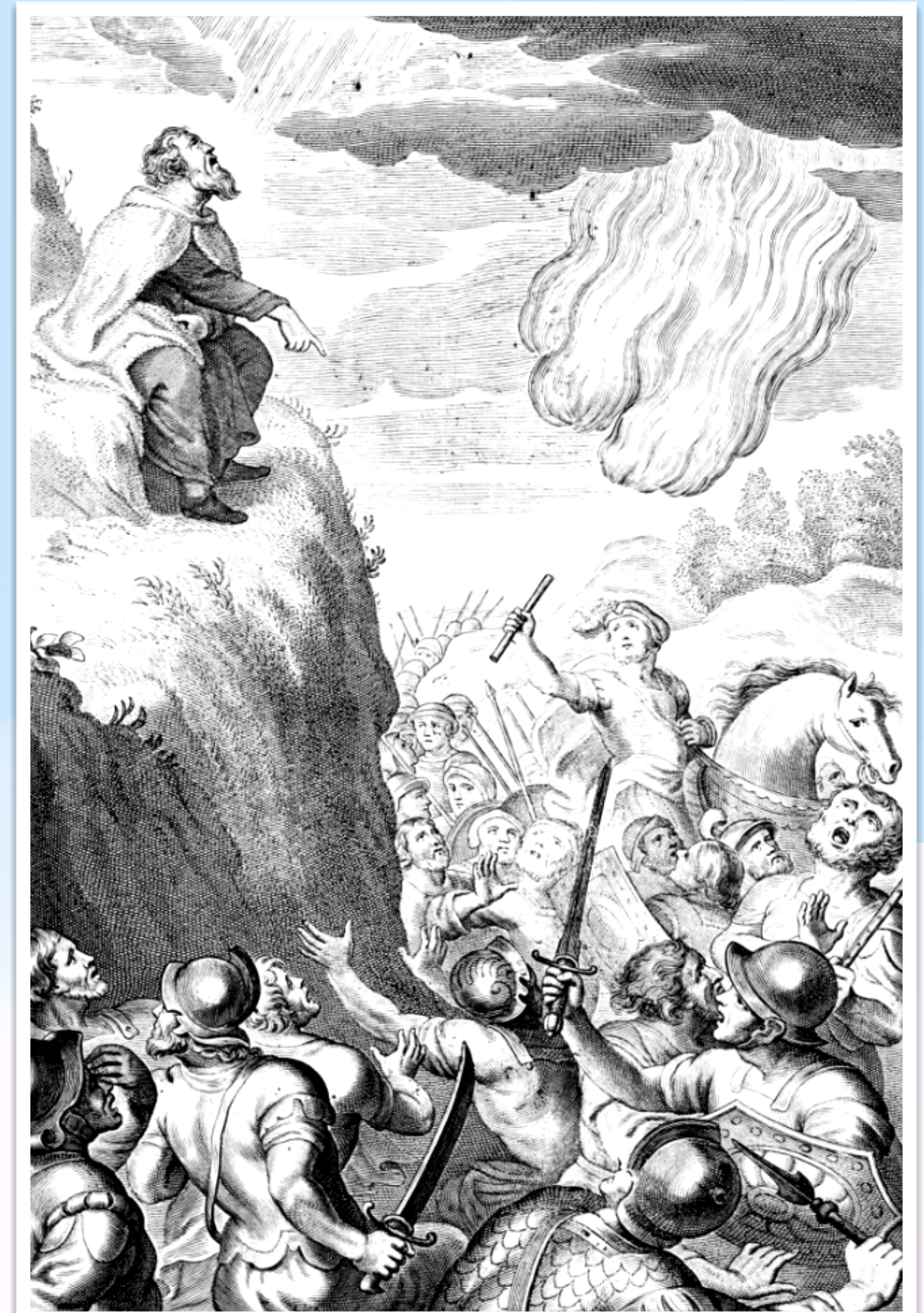
